

Family of Hugh Greenfield Sibbet**Generation No. 1**

HUGH GREENFIELD SIBBET (Son of Samuel *Sibbet Jr.*) was born August 5, 1826 in Quincy, Franklin Co., Pennsylvania, and died *March 22, 1896* in Evanston, Uinta County, Wyoming He married HANNAH LABELLE ROBISON in 1851. She was born September 15, 1825 in Moat Alto, Franklin Co., Pennsylvania, and died 1863 in Farmington, Utah.

The 1850 census reports Hugh living at home and working as a shoemaker. In 1860 he moved west and settled in Morgan Utah. Jessie Sibbet reports that Hugh joined the Mormon *Church* about 1854.

Jessie Sibbet includes a lengthy discussion of the westward migration of Hugh Greenfield ell Sibbet along with that of other Mormons, and extracts of that are included here. "In May 1860, Hugh, Hannah and their four children [James Lawry, age 8, Samuel Alexander, age 6, Nancy Ellen, age 4; and Mary Alice, age 1. The status - actual existence - of Amanda Amelia Sibbet, born 1856, is uncertain]. Along with Daniel Robison [Hannah's brother] and his wife and children, and David [another Robison brother], left Pennsylvania by train *for* Florence [Nebraska]. Two of Daniel's children died, and a third one died after reaching Florence... Daniel was chosen *to* be leader of the *9th* Handcart Company, consisting of the families of him his now, and brother, and 233 others in *forty-three* hand. Eight-year-old James Lowry Sibbet, the eldest child, was said *to* have walked every step of the way to Utah. Five-year-old Samuel Alexander walked most of the time but was glad to be put in one of the wagons with his three-year old sister. The baby, Mary Alice Sibbet, was carried by her mother or put in a wagon when her mother helped push the cart. Two more children [Amen Amanda and Mary Ann] would be born to Hugh and Hannah in other years in Utah... They reach Salt Lake City on August 27th. [1860]"
